It also takes appropriate action on requests of students for assembly, seminar, training and the like within the campus and/or the use of facilities.

VI. Auditorium

Serves as venue for various cultural shows, seminars, forums and other related activities. It is also available for rent to the public for various activities and functions.

VII. Little Theater

Serves as venue for student activities/presentations, seminars, forums, conferences and meetings.

IX. Multi-Purpose Hall

Provides venue for various sports and other school activities.

X. University Athletic Complex

Serves as venue for sports activities of the university.

XI. Graduate School Student Lounge

Serves as a venue for graduate students to comfortably take a rest and have some relaxing activities after/in between classes.

XII. Accreditation Center

Serves primarily as a venue for external quality assurance monitoring activities. However, upon approval by the administration, it can be used for academic and administrative meetings/conferences.

XIII. Wellness and Fitness Center

Provides wellness and recreational opportunities for CSU employees and students.

A. Student Councils and Student Organizations

Student Councils and Student organization serve as an active medium for student ideas and sentiments are responsible for providing all aspects for leadership for the students, promote and protect the welfare of every students from all forms of injustices, harassment and other similar acts prejudicial to his academic, moral, spiritual, physical, political and social development, promote harmonious relationship among the student, the faculty, the administration and the community in general, design and implement programs, events and activities which support and enrich the goals of the university, plan and conduct extracurricular and co-curricular activities to enhance the leadership skills, promote sense of unity, collaborative work and healthy relationships among student leaders and student organizations.

B. Student Publication

Student Publication has for its thrust an adherence to the autonomous ideals of paper designed to be responsive to pressing issues of society, to the development of the academe and its sectors, to the needs of the students, and the development of an effective campus press. It will further function as a catalyst for holistic development of the student population by exposing them to the different perspective of issues, thus, developing open – mindedness, activism and social consciousness as a whole.

C. Scholarships and Financial Assistance Services

The University through the recommendation of OSSS, provides scholarships and financial assistance to qualified and deserving students. The OSSS takes charge in monitoring all student scholarship programs and grants/financial assistance at the tertiary level. It serves as agent in linkage with other government agencies as well as private individuals to seek for scholarship, grants and financial assistance. It also assumes responsibility over the documents of student for records purposes.

D. Religious Services

Religious Organizations raised up a generation that uphold godly standards of morality and excellence through the sharing of God's word among the students of the institution promote and coordinate activities and programs that will enhance the intellectual and physical well-being and development of the students and the organizations such as seminars, prayer meeting, teachings, peer counseling, etc.

E. Guidance, counseling and Testing Services

This office spearheads moral education, anti-drug abuse campaigns and peer counseling among others. It supervises the administration of entrance examinations and psychological examinations required on entering students in all levels and evaluate when appropriate. It also supervises the maintenance of student records on cases and other referrals and results of examinations administered and render report to appropriate office.

F. Medical and Dental Services

The University medical and dental clinic renders routine and dental check-ups and primary health and dental services. It encourages awareness in the prevention and control of the spread of common epidemics and assists in the implementation of the programs of Department of Health (DOH). The office provides medical and dental services.

G. Sports Development Services

The University offers sports development program. Its sports facilities include a spacious track-and-field oval, a gymnasium, courts and facilities for various sports. It encourages the students to try out for inclusion in its various varsity teams (basketball, volleyball, soccer, softball, baseball, lawn tennis, table tennis, swimming, track and field, arnis, taekwondo, chess, badminton, boxing, sepak takraw, etc). It conducts intramurals and institutional sports competitions within the province that will compete in the regional and national SCUAA meet.

H. Culture and Arts Development Services (Hablon Dawani)

Through the Hablon Dawani, the University generates interest and participation in cultural / artistic activities by designing workshops, giving lectures staging plays, performing in school celebrations, joining national competitions, presenting exhibits and concerts and showing cultural performances. It offers scholarships to those deserving students with innate talents. The Hablon Dawani takes charge of the planning and presentation of cultural heritage of the province to the public as an extension service of the University. It also establishes linkages with other government agencies, LGUs, NGOs and other schools for the conduct of trainings in different in different aspects of theater arts.

I. Dormitory Services

It provides descent housing facilities to students and visitors. The dormitory is a two-storey concrete building away from the noise and disturbances of a crowded neighborhood.

FACILITIES

I. Multi-Purpose Gymnasium

Provides as a common venue for different types of activities such as athletics, socials, symposia, conferences, fora, and other similar events. It can also be used by outsiders provided they comply with the requirements set forth by the University.

II. Multi-Purpose Cooperative

a. Provides snacks, meals, groceries, school supplies, and photocopying services.

b. Renders Catering Service upon request.

III. Multi-Purpose Covered Court

Provides venue for various sports and school activities.

IV. Corporate Business Operations (CBO)

a. Provides stalls for rent selling foodstuffs and other students' primary needs

b. Serves as display area for the agricultural products produced by the University and offered for sale

V. Student Center

a. Serves as offices of the Federated University Student Council (FUSC) and the OSSS, respectively.

b. Serves as venue for meetings, study area, and other similar activities of students.
